Japan extended JPY 110 million grant aid (equivalent of USD 927,000) for Conflict Prevention and Peace-Building in Nigeria

The Government of Japan has decided to extend Conflict Prevention and Peace-building Grant Aid of JPY 110 million (USD 0.927 million equivalent) to the United Nations (UN) through the United Nations Office on Drugs and Crime (UNODC) for two projects: "Capacity Building for Effective Prosecution of Terrorism Offenses" and "Support to the Fight against Trafficking in Persons in Nigeria. "The Exchange of Notes (E/N) between H.E. Mr. Ryuichi SHOJI, the Ambassador of Japan to Nigeria, and Mr. Aldo LALE-DEMOZ, Deputy Executive Director and Director of the Division for Operations of UNODC, took place at the Grant Signing Ceremony for the two projects on 3 February 2015. Details of the two projects are as follows:
