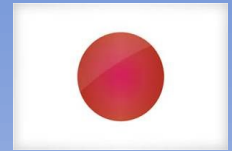

Japanese Government MEXT Scholarship For Nigerian Students 2018

Research Students

Post graduate students who wish to conduct research in Japan for PH-D/Master's degrees or non-degree course in respective fields. Applicants generally must have been born on or after April 2, 1983 (under 35 years of age)

Undergraduate Students

Students who wish to continue their studies in Japanese universities for undergraduate degrees. Applicants generally must have been born between April 2, 1996 and April 1, 2001. (between 17 to 22 years of age)

College of Technology Students

Students who wish to study in Japan as students at a college of technology, Mechanical/Electronic Engineering, etc. Applicants generally must have been born between April 2, 1996 and April 1, 2001. (between 17 to 22 years of age)

Specialized Training College Students

Students who wish to study in Japan as a student at a specialized training college, Technology, Business, Fashion, Culture, etc. Applicants generally must have been born between April 2, 1996 and April 1, 2001 (between 17 to 22 years of age)
