Venue and Date: Lambata Community in Gurara Local Government Area in Niger State on 30th May 2018

Granted Amount: US\$82,742

Implementing Partner NGO: Centre for Development & Partnership

Project Content: Before the construction, students encountered shortage of school facilities. The students were in congested classrooms with up to 80 students in a classroom, and some of them used to study without desks and chairs or share one desk with 4 to 5 other students. Now it is handed over that 6 new classrooms, 2 staff rooms, 2 stockrooms, 160 sets of student desks with chairs, 12 toilets, 14 teacher' tables, 28 chairs and 3 shelves. As a result, the project not only makes the hygiene and sanitation of the children at the school significantly improved but also enables the school to receive additional 100 children and 10 teachers.
