Project Content: In Upu Community there was no single health facility and medical services were not easily accessible. Given this challenging situation, the Government of Japan has provided USD 105,324 (equivalent to 8,636,568 Japanese yen) to construct a new health centre equipped with medical devices and furniture. From now on, Upu Health Centre will serve for the needs of Upu residents by providing primary health care treatment.

Mr. Daisuke Nagatani, the First Secretary of the Embassy of Japan, Chairman of Otukpo Local Government Area, and the community people participated in the commissioning ceremony. The handover of the Health Clinic has given the comfort and vitality to the local residents.
