

Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Project (Signing Ceremony)

The Embassy of Japan signed 4 grant contracts of Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP) on 27th January 2016. Since 1998, we have implemented 152 grassroots projects in Nigeria in the field of education, health, infrastructure etc.

Project Content:

- 1. “The Project for Construction of Local Government Education Authority Angwa Dio Primary School in Gwagwalada Area Council in the Federal Capital Territory”**
To improve the educational and hygienic conditions at the Angwa Dio Primary School by constructing new classrooms and procuring furniture for pupils and teachers.
✂Total Grant : USD 90,604 (equivalent to 9,966,440 Japanese yen)
✂NGO: Change Managers International Network
- 2. “The Project for Construction of Durumi Vocational Training Centre in Bwari Area Council in the Federal Capital Territory”**
To increase the access to vocational training for women and the youth by constructing a vocational training facility, a fence, a gate house and a manual borehole, and procuring training equipment and furniture in the Durumi community.
✂Total Grant : USD 89,819 (equivalent to 9,880,090 Japanese yen)
✂NGO: Tabitha Cumi Foundation
- 3. “The Project for Procurement of Medical Equipment for Bwari General Hospital in Bwari Area Council in the Federal Capital Territory”**
To enhance the medical services of obstetrics and gynaecology by procuring medical equipment and tools, and furniture to Bwari General Hospital.
✂Total Grant : USD 89,662 (equivalent to 9,862,820 Japanese yen)
✂NGO: Women’s Right to Education Programme
- 4. “The Project for Construction of Shere Koko Primary Health Centre in Bwari Area Council in the Federal Capital Territory”**
To increase the access to maternal, child, and primary health care services and enhance hygienic conditions in the Shere Koko community by constructing a primary health centre and a borehole, and procuring medical equipment and solar panels.
✂Total Grant : USD 90,530 (equivalent to 9,958,300 Japanese yen)
✂NGO: Citizens’Health Education and Development Initiative
