<u>Summary</u>: Government of Japan has extended grant assistance worth Nine Hundred and Eighty million Japanese Yen (980,000,000 JPY) (equivalent to approx. 8.72 million USD) to install the photovoltaic (PV) panel which is expected to generate approximately 1.496MWh at the premises of Usman Dam Water Treatment Plant under Japan's Cool Earth Partnership Programme, which aims at realizing both reducing global greenhouse gas emission and economic growth so as to address Climate Change. Though the 1st Commissioning Ceremony was already held on 23rd August 2016, the 2nd Commissioning Ceremony was held again to mark the final completion of the project at the occasion of the completion of installation of additionally procured PV panels. Mr. Masaya OTSUKA, the Deputy Head of Mission of Japan to Nigeria, representatives from Minister for Power, Works & Housing, FCTA, and so on, attended the Commissioning Ceremony.
