“The Construction of Gbogbodo Maternal and Child Health Centre”
(Commissioning Ceremony)

Date : 24th October 2016

Project Content : Until now, many members of the Gbogbodo community, especially pregnant women and children had lost their lives due to lack of adequate and swift medical services in close proximity. This unpleasant situation has initiated the intervention of the Government of Japan to provide US\$92,804 (equivalent to 9,001,988 Japanese yen) to construct a medical facility, provide adequate medical equipment, tools and furniture as well as a hand-pump borehole to the community, through the implementation partner; Church of the Brethren in Nigeria.

Dr Yoshiharu Furuichi, Counsellor, Embassy of Japan in Nigeria, chief of Gbogbodo community, representatives of Abaji Area Council, Primary Health Care and the community participated in the commissioning ceremony. The handover of the new health facilities has given hope to the entire Gbogbodo community.
