The Project for Introduction of Clean Energy by Solar Electricity Generation System (Commissioning Ceremony)

Summary: Government of Japan has extended grant assistance worth Nine Hundred and Eighty million Japanese Yen (980,000,000 JPY) (equivalent to approx. 8.72 million USD) to install the photovoltaic (PV) panel which is expected to generate approximately 1,496MWh at the premises of Usuman dam water Treatment Plant under Japan's Cool Earth Partnership Programme, which aims at realizing both reducing global greenhouse gas emission and economic growth so as to address Climate Change. This would result in reduction of 31 million Naira/ year for payment of electricity bill, and 741t/ year of CO2. In addition, this project is expected to contribute to improve quality of the portable water which Usuman dam water Treatment Plant provides to approximately 40,000 residents in FCT.
