<u>Summary</u>: The output of the generator No.4 has decreased and its lifespan has been shortened due to the accident in 2009. The Government of Japan has extended the aid of JPY 1.990 billion (equivalent of USD 16.6 million) to repair and overhaul the generator No. 4 to recover its original output and lengthen its lifespan for at least 30 years.
