Japan Granted US\$454,510 for 6 Projects

The Government of Japan approved 6 community-based projects with the amount of US\$454,510 (N138, 625,550) under the Japanese Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP). On 15th March 2018, Mr. Sadanobu Kusaoke, Ambassador of Japan signed the grant contracts with 6 NGOs (See the details below).

1	Afripride Multi-purpose Cooperative Society	The Project for Construction of Agricultural Vocational Training Centre in Gwagwalada Area Council in the Federal Capital Territory	Construction of an agricultural vocational training centre for women and the youth, which will provide practical skills in fishery, poultry, and animal husbandry.
2	Cry for Help for the Needy Foundation	The Project for Improvement of Primary Health Care in Nasarawa Local Government Area in Nasarawa State	Refurbishment of a health care facility, which will improve the access to better medical care.
3	Development Dynamics Foundation	The Project for Installation of Solar Street Lighting in Ezinihitte Local Government Area in Imo State	Installation of solar powered street lighting that will illuminate the major roads in Ezeagbogu community, improve safety and security, and encourage economic activities after sunset. The solar lightning will be procured from a Japanese company, Koyo Corporation.
4	Godwin Odiowa Foundation	The Project for Construction of Fish Processing Facility in Calabar South Local Government Area in Cross River State	Construction of modern fish processing facility, which eliminates the negative impacts of the local processing method and equally contributes immensely to the economic empowerment of the community.
5	Lift Above Poverty Organization	The Project for Construction of Rice Mill Facility in Etsako Central Local Government Area in Edo State	Construction of a modern rice mill that will improve the quality and quantity of rice.
6	Street to School Initiative	The Project for Improvement of Primary Health Care in Alimosho Local Government Area in Lagos State	Installment of essential medical facilities in Ikola community where pregnant women and sick children are often faced with precarious situations due to the lack of adequate medical care.
