

As Many As 180 Women and Youths Annually Can Now Receive Vocational Training

The Embassy of Japan announces that Iglaba Vocational Training Centre in Obudu Local Government Area in Cross River State has been completed and the newly constructed facility was handed over to the Iglaba community by the Ambassador of Japan to Nigeria. Ambassador Kikuta, Representative of Governor of Cross River, Director of International Donors at Obudu Local Government, the chief of the community and local residents were present at the commissioning ceremony. As a result of this project, 180 trainees in the first year, and 240 trainees in the following year will benefit from the training centre.
