

100 Japanese Quality Solar Powered Street Lights Switched on in Imo State

“The Project for Installation of Solar Street Lighting in Ezinihitte Local Government Area in Imo State” has been completed and 100 street lights were handed over to Ezeagbogu Community, Ezinihitte Local Government Area at the handover ceremony, with the presence of Japanese Ambassador to Nigeria, H.E. Yutaka Kikuta and the Executive Governor of Imo State, H.E. Hon. Chukwuemeka Ihedioha. The ceremony was held on 16th July 2019.

The street lights were manufactured and installed by a Japanese company, Koyo Corporation, which trained the youth in the community so that they can maintain this solar powered street-lighting system, thereby enabling technology transfer from Japan to Nigeria.

The Embassy of Japan hopes that this assistance will contribute to improvement of safety in the community, and will strengthen the amicable relationship between Japan and Nigeria
