Grant Contract Signing

21st January 2021

Japan signed a grant contract of US\$90,053 for a project to construct and equip Aso Pada Primary Healthcare Center to deliver quality healthcare in Nasarawa State.

On 21st January 2021, Mr. KIKUTA Yutaka, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to the Federal Republic of Nigeria, signed a grant contract of US\$90,053 with Citizen's Health Education and Development Initiative (CHEDI) to construct and equip a primary healthcare center in Aso Pada community, Karu Local Government Area of Nasarawa State under the Japanese Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP). Since 1998, over 170 projects with a total amount of US\$12 million have been implemented throughout Nigeria under the GGP scheme.

Ms. Selina Akunna Enyioha, Executive Director for Citizen's Health Education and Development Initiative (CHEDI), signed the grant contract on behalf of CHEDI. The project will provide quality healthcare service for the Aso Pada Community in Karu Local Government Area of Nasarawa State through construction and equipping of a primary healthcare center. Japan hopes to enhance regional healthcare service, which is crucially important in the midst of the COVID-19 global pandemic, and to strengthen the amicable relationship between Japan and Nigeria.
