

Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Project (GGP)

Grant Contract Signing

16th February 2021

Japan signed a grant contract of US\$90,110 for a project to construct and equip rural clinics in Nasarawa State.

On 16th February 2021, Mr. KIKUTA Yutaka, Ambassador Extraordinary and Plenipotentiary of Japan to the Federal Republic of Nigeria, and a representative of the Christian Broadcasting Network (CBN Africa) Dr. Felix Oisamoje, Regional Director for CBN Africa signed a Grant Contract of US\$90,110 under the Japanese Grant Assistance for Grassroots Human Security Projects (GGP). Since 1998, over 175 projects with a total amount of US\$12.8 million have been implemented throughout Nigeria under the GGP scheme.

The project will provide quality healthcare services for two communities in Karu Local Government Area and Nasarawa Local Government Area of Nasarawa State through the construction and equipping of primary healthcare centers. Japan hopes these projects be effectively utilized to enhance regional healthcare services, which are crucially important in the midst of the COVID-19 global pandemic, and to strengthen the amicable relationship between Japan and Nigeria.
