Japan Granted US\$ 155,877 for Provision of Medical Equipment to University of Abuja Teaching Hospital

The Embassy of Japan announces that “The Project for Procurement of Medical Equipment for the University of Abuja Teaching Hospital, Gwagwalada Area Council in the Federal Capital Territory” has been completed and the medical equipment has been handed over to the University of Abuja Teaching Hospital at a commissioning ceremony, in the presence of the Japanese Ambassador to Nigeria, H.E. Mr. MATSUNAGA Kazuyoshi, Mr. ONO Yasuhiro from Taichi Holdings as a technical partner, and doctors in the hospital. The ceremony was held on 22nd February 2022.

A Japanese company, Taichi Holdings, procured the medical equipment and arranged equipment technical assistance. The University of Abuja Teaching Hospital led the project as an implementing partner as well as a beneficiary.

The Embassy of Japan hopes that this assistance will contribute to the improvement in the delivery of healthcare to infants in the Federal Capital Territory and will further strengthen the amicable relationship between Japan and Nigeria.
