The Embassy of Japan announces that “The Project for the Construction and Equipping of Rural Clinics in Karu Local Government Area (Gidan Gimba Community) and Nasarawa Local Government Area (Arishi Community) of Nasarawa State” has been completed and handed over to Christian Broadcasting Network Africa at a commissioning ceremony, in the presence of Charged’ Affaires a.i. of the Embassy of Japan in Nigeria, Mr. SHINOZAWA Takayuki, Dr. OISAMOJE Felix who is a Regional Director of Christian Broadcasting Network Africa, Mr. AUDI Danjuma who is Chief of Gidan Gimba and more. The ceremony was held on the 13th September 2022.

Christian Broadcasting Network Africa led the project as an implementing partner, and the community being the beneficiary.
